I wanted to send a fast message to our chapter members to recap our 2009 activities, thank everyone for their help in getting the chapter off to a very strong start, and to wish everyone a safe and enjoyable holiday season.

2009 was a busy year for us - our chapter was approved in March of 2009. We hosted a kick off meeting at GE-GRC on April 30; about 30 people attended this meeting and we exchanged a lot of valuable information. Our first scientific meeting was held at the Holiday Inn, Wolf Road on June 23; this meeting had 6 talks, 11 poster presentations, and about 35 attendees. Eric Bersch, from the College of Nanoscale Science and Engineering, won the best presentation award. The second scientific meeting was held at The College of Nanoscale Science and Engineering on Oct 13; this meeting consisted of 6 talks, 21 poster presentations, and had about 52 people. Saurabh Garg, from RPI, won the best presentation award. We are gaining momentum with each meeting!
